This month, we were invited to talk at the City of London, Romance Fraud awareness day for law enforcement. It was an action packed day listening to Victim's stories, cases that had been investigated and secured successful convictions as well as our own presentation which gave an insight into the tools and tricks used by scammers, the lengths they go to and the victim blaming stigma, along with the impacts this has on recovery. Dr Elisabeth Carter explained about the language used and how this can be aligned with that in coercive and controlling relationships.
