Other advocating came from discussing AI (Artificial Intelligence) and the place this has in Romance Fraud, as a tool for scammers to further convince victims of their legitimacy. Voice cloning, deep fake video calls and AI software to blend the required faces onto photos or videos. This technology has evolved from the older practice of photoshopped pictures and saved videos for the video calls.
